Workshop "Identification of vulnerable persons (victims of human trafficking, people suffering from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder, or with psychological disorders) in the frames of administrative proceedings" was carried out in the Border Guard Centre for Specialised Training in Luban from 22 to 25 September, 2015. The participants of this training were the psychologists and people working inside secure facilities from various Border Guard Regional Units as well as representatives of the Office for Foreigners and Regional Government Offices. A substantial support to the workshop was given by external experts who described the methods of diagnosing foreigners from vulnerable groups, especially unaccompanied minors. During workshop the participants had the possibility to familiarise with various forms of psychological disorders of foreigners who

are being sent to Poland on the basis of Dublin III agreement, as well as procedures of sharing information about the vulnerable foreigners' situation between Health Service and the border guards working in Foreigners' Affairs Departments.
